A colorful mural by Stuart White and a train motif provide an excellent backdrop for an extensive menu, featuring regional American specialties at reasonable prices. The terrace is open daily for lunch and dinner.

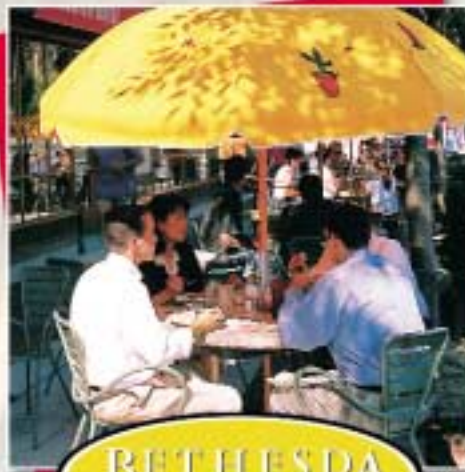

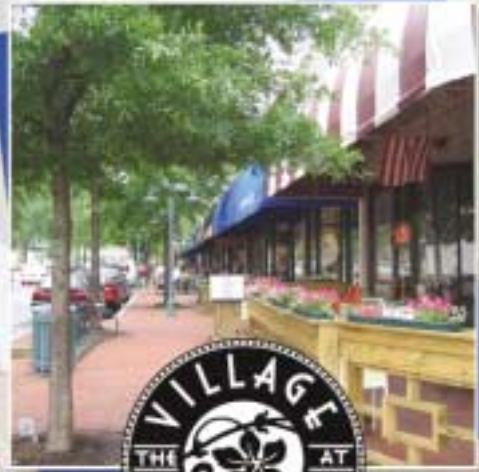
